

Level 2 Award Emergency First Aid at Work

Introduction

The course will familiarise students with the roles and responsibilities of the Emergency First Aider, including assessing an incident, recognising signs and symptoms of injury and illness, and assisting a casualty who is suffering from injury and illness.

Students will learn and be assessed on their practical ability to deal with casualties who have stopped breathing, are unconscious, are bleeding and suffering from shock.

Objectives

Delegates will be able to:

- Identify the role and responsibilities of an emergency first aider
- Describe how to conduct a scene survey
- Demonstrate how to assess a casualty's level of consciousness
- Demonstrate how to treat a casualty who is choking
- Describe signs and symptoms of shock
- understand how to manage a casualty with a minor injury
